Abstract: Many studies have investigated the presence of microplastics in urban and suburban areas. Fewer studies have addressed the presence of microplastics in rural systems. In this study, we evaluated the presence of microplastics in runoff from land applied biosolids and the occurrence of microplastics in Nebraska waterways. Our studies show that microplastics are routinely present in agricultural systems, and we will examine current research, challenges, and potential solutions for mitigating these risks.
